Quality Abounds At Cheyenne Dispersal

There's a host of quality breeding stock on offer at Hetta Dollery's Cheyenne Stud dispersal. The sale will be held on the farm on Friday 19 May at 12.30. Catalogues are available from Bloodstock South Africa, which runs the sale. KAREL MIEDEMA takes a look at the opportunities, the mares listed by sire. Many of the mares also have their 2005 foals on offer.

Al Mufti (Roberto)

Two-time winning mare Lady Judist (20) is bred on the cross with Quick Turnover (5r/5w), which represents inbreeding 3x3 to Buckpasser, the affinity which suits Al Mufti so well. Here's a chance to build further on that, through Buckpasser's affinity-lines (Nijinsky, Tom Fool, Blushing Groom, Dinner Partner, etc.).

Argosy (Affirmed)

Plum Choice (33) is a half sister to stakes placed Jack Horner (a cracker, who sadly ran only a few times). Their dam Plum Picker was a stakes placed winner of 3 races. Argosy is the damsire of some good winners, including Vega (Jallad), Royal IQ (Dominion Royale), Amberpondo (Model Man).

Averof (Sing Sing)

Jane's The Name (15) has bred 7 winners to date, from different sires, including Gr3 winner Name The Key. The mare is a half sister to five other black type producing mares, which tells a story.

Bush Telegraph (Jungle Cove)

Bush Temptress (52), half sister to 6 winners (one dam of a stakes winner). Bush Telegraph mares have produced major winners Flight Alert (National Assembly) and Promisefrommyheart (Fort Wood).

News Roller (30) is a half sister to the dam of Gr3 winner Rattlebag, the pair daughters of French Gr3 placed mare Rattle (Riverman). News Roller, a winner of 2 races, is the dam of 2 winners.

Coastal (Majestic Prince)

Like The Wind (23) is a half sister to 4 stakes performers and to the dam of another, all out of highclass mare Winter Lass. The mare is the dam of 2 winners to date.

Comic Blush (Blushing Groom)

Winning mare She's My Hero (42) has bred 2 winners to date, from different sires. Comic Blush is the damsire of La deportista (Sportsworld), Ethno Centric (Centenary) and Storm Flo (Royal Flo).

Complete Warrior (Dewan)

Mumm (26) is a half sister to 8 winners, 3 of them black type performers, out the mare Champagne Flirt (Flirting Around). This is the highclass Bonza Bay female line.

Gr1 winner Nobely Born (31) is a daughter of Gr2 placed stakes winner Dame D'or (Golden Thatch). She's had one

runner to date, a 2-time winner.

Gr3 winner Complete Lee (53) has produced 3 winners to date, including Gr2 placed stakes winner Sharlee Boy. The mare is a half sister to two other black type producing mares out of French bred Miss Lee (Sir Ribot).

Complete Warrior is the sire of mares who produced Captain Al (Al Mufti) & Shadow Dancing (Fort Wood), and Roman Charger (Al Mufti).

Concertino (Lyphard)

Lantina (22) is a full sister to Gr1 placed Gr2 winner Admiralty Arch out of New Zealand mare Sovereign Lana (Sovereign Edition).

Concertino's daughters have produced Gr winner Rip Curl (National Emblem) and She Can Dance (Manshood).

Concerto (Orpheus)

Imported mare Floria (8) is a winner of two races, from an American female line which also produced highclass 3yo Hunting Tower and sprint filly Mocha Java.

The mare is inbred intentionally through In Reality & a daughter of Cequillo. Conventional wisdom dictates, in this case, that more of these same lines should be added - Natal sire Albarahin possibly a suitable match.

Cordoba (El Gran Senor)

Lovely broodmare sire in the making, his daughters on the map with Zolaroyale (Dominion Royale), Hello Margarita (Sportsworld) and 2yo Syrian Sonja (Damascus Gate).

Stakes placed Malaguena (25), full sister to 2 black type winners, has a European black type family background.

Luisa (24) is a half sister to champion Spook Express, with the mare's grandam a half sister to sire Elliodor.

Damascus Gate (Damascus)

Gates Of Heaven (13) is a 2-time winning full sister to Gr2 winner Your Eminence, from the potent Swan lake female line. She's the dam of a 6-time winner by Harmony Forever.

Dancing Champ (Nijinsky)

Lady And The Champ (19) is a daughter of Gr1 winner Young Lady (Jungle Cove), and half sister to 3 stakes performers. She has produced 3 winners to date.

Fleet Girl (7) bred an 11-time winner and a 6-time winner (stakes placed); 3 of her four runners to date are winners. The mare is a half sister to July winner Gondolier, to stakes winner Dainty Di, and to the dam of San Carlos.

Del Sarto (Bold Bidder)

Forest Angel (10) is a multiple Gr2 placed winner, and dam of Gr1 Nursery winner Forest Trogon as well as a multiple winner by Saumarez. If you get her in foal again, the reward could be high - Del Sarto mares, generally speaking, certainly have done their bit.

Dominion Royale (Dominion)

Regal Pose (36) is a winner, and dam of a winner. Grandam Athir (Be My Guest) comes from a highclass Irish female line; her own dam is a half sister to sire Rambo Dancer, the next dam a half sister to sire Liloy.

Elliodor (Lyphard)

Royal Reserve (39) is a 3-part sister to Champion 2yo Private Reserve, from an English female line. Her oldest progeny is a 2yo.

Muthaiga (27) is a winner of 2 races and dam of a 5-time winner (by Harmony Forever), from the family of Sea Cottage's siter Bonza Bay. The mare is a 3-part sister to stakes winner La Diabliesse. Frankfort (11), winner of 3 races and dam of a winner, comes from the very same female line.

Kokkewiet (18) is a Gr2 placed Gr3 winner of six races, and full sister to stakes placed Sherry Elizabeth. Her oldest living representative is a weanling.

Exclusive Patriot (Exclusive Native)

Five time winning mare Sunspire (46) is the dam of one previous foal. The mare's dam is inbred 4x4 to Bold Ruler and 2x4 to Damascus.

Faraway Dancer (Far North)

Key Dancer (17) is a winning half sister to 9 other winners out of Key Affair, who comes from a female line which traces to

stakes horses and to the dam of another. This is the female line of Reville Boy, Super Magic and Command Control.

Model Man (Elliodor)

Champion 2yo Private Reserve (34) is bound to attract attention. Her only foal to date to have raced is a winner.

Fair Model (5), multiple Gr1 placed Gr1 winner, is another successful daughter of Model Man. She's the dam of highclass Young Warrior and 2 other winners from 3 foals to race. Her current 2yo is a Fort Wood filly. This is the family of Hawaii.

National Assembly (Danzig)

National Dame (28) is a winning half sister to Guineas winner St John's Wood, from the potent speed female line of Phantom Earl and Extra Cover.

National Sensation (29) is a 2yo filly for stud. Her dam is a 2-time winning half sister to 8 winners including Natal Derby winner Royal Land, and also is half sister to a yearling filly which fetched R1.6 million at the recent National Sale.

Nissr (Nijinsky)

Flying Pegasus (9) is a Zimbabwe bred half sister to stakes placed Johnny Angel, the next dam a half sister to Gr1 winner Fair Model. Nissr is the damsire of stakes winners Battle Maiden and Mist Of Gold (full sisters, by Goldkeeper).

Noble Ambition (Danzig)

Two-time winner Venus Fix (47) is the dam of a winner, from a top speed-family.

Dollar Help (4) is a winning half sister to 3 winners, the next dam a full sister to the dam of three stakes winners. This is the family of Majestic Crown.

Seven-time winner Salut l'Artiste (41) is the dam of a 4-time winner, from 3 foals to race. The mare is a half sister to two stakes horses, from the Mildenhall family.

Noble Ambition is the broodmare sire of stakes winners Oracle West and What A Prophet (full brothers by Western Winter).

Northern Guest (Northern Dancer)

Gr1 J&B Met winner Imperious Sue (14) has produced two winners to date, including stakes winner Blue Heather. The mare is a half sister stakes winner City State, their

dam a full sister to the dam of Victory Moon - the latter is by Al Mufti, also the sire of Imperious Sue's current yearling who is a full sister in blood to the champion.

Solveig's Song (44) is a 3-time winning daughter of Gr1 winner Bombarda, from an Argentinian female line.

Pitador (Laramie Trail)

Stakes placed 4-time winner Airtex (49) is a half sister to Gr2 winner Copper Tan and to the dam of Gr2 placed Ice Lily. Her first four foals to race are all winners.

Rakeen (Northern Dancer)

She's So Keen (43) is a winning filly for stud. Her dam is out of a half sister to the dams of stakes winners Kal Sufi and Brave Voyager.

Rakeen mares have produced Far de Vie (Fard), Orange Alert (Goldkeeper) and Look Skyward (Qui Danzig).

Royal Chalice (Royal Prerogative)

First Harvest (6) is the winning dam of stakes placed Royal Harvest, and of 3-time winner Harvest Dance, her only two foals to have raced so far. The female line is English/American.

Royal Chalice mares have produced Hunting Tower (Fort Wood), Roxanne (Western Winter) and Surabi (Wolfhound).

Secret Prospector (Mr Prospector)

Gr2 placed winner Juno's Myth (16) is a half sister to Gr3 winner Old Rituals (dam of black type performers) and to Gr2 placed Olden Times. Top female line, as the third dam is a half sister to famous mare Mixed Marriage.

Secret Prospector mares have produced Elusive Fort (Fort Wood), Key Of Destiny (Qui Danzig).

Steady Beat (Alydar)

Resolute Rose (37) is a 2-time winning half sister to 9 winners including Natal Derby winner Royal Land, and also the a R1.6 million yearling at the 2006 National Sale. The mare's third dam is a full sister to sire Bold Ruler. The mare is the dam of a 6-time winner.

Steady Beat's daughters have produced Sovereign Beat (National Emblem) and Great Rhythm (I'm Great).
