#1 Makuba is a daughter of The Sheik, sire of recent Gr3 placed filly Asian Affair and several other decent winners from fairly limited opportunities to date. This yearling is the first foal of Copperbelt mare Ndola, who won four races over 1000/1100m and who in turn is a daughter of Listed winner Vague Affair.

#2 Bhut Jolokiasa colt by Opera King out of a winner pro-ucing mare by Daarik, who her-self won 2 over 1900/2000m. This is the family of European SWs.

#3 Luxoria is a colt by The Sheik out of a winning Arg-bred mare by Perfect Parade and is the half brother to one winner from only two runners out of the mare. There are Arg- Gr2 winners in the family.

#4 Trean is by Lavery. This filly is out of a dual winning Saladin mare whose only foal to race has won. The 2nd dam produced 8 winners from 9 runners.

#5 Western Star is from the first crop of Red Ransom horse Way West, a Gr3 winner in Aus. This yearling, a colt, is the first foal of Rambo Dancer mare Nombulelo, who won once over 2400m and who is the full sister to 7 times winner Howzat.

#6 Sun Goddess is a daughter of Gypsy's Warning's sire Mogok out of a Northfields mare and is the half sister to 2 winners. The dam is a half sister to multiple Stakes winning sprinter Colour Sensation, and to 6 other winners.

#7 Reindeer Park is by Woodborough, a consistent sire whose son Egyptian Ra has been so successful in Hong Kong. This yearling is the half sister to three winners, including the 3 times winner Flag Dance, and is out of a winning Dancing Champ mare from the immediate family of Kipketer and promising Cape 3yo Moonlight Gambler.

#8 Echo Beach is from the first crop of AP Indy horse Mon Sang. This colt is out of a young non-winning Goldmark mare who has not yet been represented at the races.

#9 Regent's Parade is a colt from the first SA crop of Sadler's Wells' outstanding son King Of Kings, sire of numerous Gr1 winners abroad including New Zealand champion King's Chapel. This yearling is the first foal of a Rich Man's Gold mare who won 2 up to 1200m and is a great grandson of champion filly Vesta.

#10 Nomzane is a colt by Mogok out of a dual winning Arg-bred mare by Ahmad. The dam's only foal to race has won 2 races.

#11 Outback King is another son of Mogok and is out of the Stakes-placed Aus-bred mare Queen Of Aus, a daughter of Al Hareb who won 4 over 1000/1100m in SA. The mare is a half sister to dual Aus Gr2 winner Merry Ruler and is the dam of one winner.

#12 Artistically Done is a filly by leading sire National Emblem, sire in 2009 already of Gr1 winners Emblem Of Liberty and Rebel King. This yearling is out of an unraced Elliodor mare who is the half sister to Gr2 winner Sand, from a solid black type family. Second dam Smart As Paint was a Gr1 winner.

#13 Young Royal is from the

Michael Holmes Bloodstock hosts the inaugural Autumn Yearling Sale at the Pietermaritzburg Showgrounds on Monday 11 May, when 69 lots are catalogued to come under the hammer. Predominantly (although not exclusively) the progeny of KZN-based sires, the yearlings on offer are by a variety of proven and new stallions and there are some attractive looking lots in the catalogue. Let's take a quick look at them, in numerical order, writes MATTHEW LIPS.

very promising first crop of Dubai horse-of-the-year Victory Moon. This colt is the 1st foal of a Jallad mare who won one race over 1600m. The dam is a half sister to Gr2 winner and Gr1 runner-up Hawaiian Wahoo, who was by Victory Moon's sire Al Mufti. There are black type winners throughout this family and this colt could be one of the sale's star attractions.

#14 Teesside is a daughter of Kabool and is the half sister to no fewer than 7 winners incl. Listed winner Summer Season, 5 times winner Pots And Pans, and four times winner Sacred Sea. This is the family of Royal Chalce, Honour The Guest, Set Afire, Nania, and a host of other high class performers.

#15 Beware The Queen is a filly by Opera King out of a three times winning Folmar mare and is the half sister to 2 winners. The dam is the full sister to SW Master Beware.

#16 King Of Quality is a King Of Kings colt out of a winning Harry Hotspru mare whose only foal to race has won. This is the family of champions Rain Forest, Hot Corn, Festive Season and, more recently, exported Festive.

#17 Victoria Wood is a Woodborough filly. She is the 1st foal of a Martinielli mare who is the half sister to Gr3 winner Glenforth, from the family of champion stayer Speedy Dollar.

#18 King O'Dreams is a colt by King Of Kings out of a winning daughter of excellent broodmare sire Al Mufti and is the half brother to 4 winners of seven races incl. Gr2 runner-up The Walk. There is plenty of black type further down the page.

#19 Las Ramblas is from the second crop of Danehill horse Toreador, sire of several winners already. This filly is out of the winning NZ-bred Maroof mare Silent Kiss, whose only foal to race has won. The dam is a half sister to SW and Gr1 runner-up Danyon.

#20 Obi Wan is a colt by Medaaly, sire of numerous SWs in Europe. The yearling is out of a 3 times winning Al Mufti mare and is the half brother to decent KZN sprinter Kabamba. This is the family of Gr1 winner Corning Touch, unbeaten Gr3 winner Corn Belt, and more recently of Gr2 winner State Factor.

#21 Monroe Enquiry is a filly by Modus Vivendi, sire of recent SW Ultra Vires. She is out of a winning Qui Danzig mare and is the half sister to three time winner Rutana, from the family of Buy And Sell, Count The Money, and Bedloe's Island.

#22 Eloise is a filly by The Sheik out of a winning Elliodor mare and is the half sister to four times winner El Romantico. There is considerably black type further down the page.

#23 Spartan is by freshman sire Mon Sang and is the first foal of a young Northern Guest mare from the same family as #22.

#24 Luminosity is a colt by The Sheik and is the half brother to 3

winners incl. 3 times winner Leading Man. This is the family of 3 times Gr1 winner Jungle Rock.

#25 Day Of Dreams is a filly by Albarahin, whose two SWs to date have both been fillies. She is out of a Slew Per Sovereign mare who won one race over 1600m, from the family of Gr3 winner Shoes Of Silver.

#26 Hills Of Sun is a Toreador colt out of a Sunny North mare who won seven races up to 1200m. He's the half brother to one winner from only two foals to race out of the mare.

#27 Smooth Sorbet is a filly by Mogok out of a Dolpour mare who won 4 races and is the half sister to a two times winning sprinter. The 3yo full sister was recently placed and is threatening to win at any time.

#28 Syrian Sheik is a colt by The Sheik out of a winning mare by Damascus Gate who has not yet been represented at the races. The dam is the half sister to a 6 times winner, from the family of Gr3 winner Key Decision, who promised much before his short career was terminated through injury.

#29 The Real Blonde is a filly by Second Empire out of a Listed winning, Gr3pl Whover mare who won 7 over 1400/1600m. This youngster is the half bro to 2 wnrs incl. 5 times wnrr Fellow Man.

#30 Tamborello is from the 3rd crop of 2000 Guineas runner-up and Gr3 producing sire Tamburlaine. This colt is the first foal of a Kefaah mare who won one race over 1400m.

#31 Stunning Guy is from the 3rd crop of Modus Vivendi and is the first foal of a daughter of multiple champion broodmare sire Northern Guest. The mare who won three races over 1200/1700m.

#32 Vista is a daughter of Gr1 producing sire Silvino and is the first foal of a mare by Kahir Almaydan who won one race over 1600m. The dam is a half sister to a Gr2 placed performer in Zim.

#33 Mr Charisma is a colt by internationally successful sire Caesour out of a three times winning West Man mare whose only foal to race has won. The dam is the half sister to a 5 times winner and there is considerable black type through the pedigree, making this a yearling to look at closely.

#34 South For Suez is a colt by The Sheik out of a Muftal mare who has not yet been represented at the races. The dam is a half sister to dual Stakes placed 5 times winner Lady Red.

#35 Crowned Prince is a colt by King Of Kings out of a mare by Dolpour. The half brother to one winner from the family of multiple Gr1 winner Teal, this youngster is in-bred 3x2 to Sadler's Wells.

#36 Smiler Blue is a colt by The Sheik out of a winning mare by Singing Boy and is the half brother to 1 winner from only 2 foals to race out of the dam. The mare's a half sister to 5 winners.

#37 is an unnamed daughter of Green Desert horse Pissaro and is the half sister to former Gr3

winning juvenile Mr Flatley. The dam won twice up to 1400m and is the half sister to five times Gr1 winning sprinter Signor Amigo, so this yearling looks bred to fly.

#38 Spirit Of Ecstasy is a filly by freshman sire Way West (Red Ransom) and is the first foal of a daughter of handy broodmare sire Centenary. The dam won one race over 1600m and is the full or half sister to 7 winners.

#39 Vaganova is a filly by Second Empire and is the first foal of Goldmark mare Blue Jean Baby, who won five races over 1200/1400m and who finished 2nd in a Listed event. The dam is the full sister to SW and Gr1 placed My Squeeze, who herself in turn is the dam of Gr3 placed Calpurnia.

#40 Redsea Swallow is a filly by Mogok. She's the 2nd foal of a winning mare by Elliodor, whose one previous offspring is a winner. Second dam Yasnaya won 6 races and was Gr2 pl. This is the family of Gr1 wnr Vistula and Gr2 wnrs Muscovy and Sovereign Seas.

#41 Wayward Wind is a colt from the 1st crop of Way West and is the half brother to 2 winners incl. 3 times winner Accord. The NZ-bred dam won one race over 2000m and is the half sister to a Gr3 winner in her native country.

#42 Magic Monarch is a son of King Of Kings and is out of the All Fired Up mare Conjurer, who won 5 races over 1300/2000m. The mare has only been represented at the course by one lightly raced runner to date.

#43 King's Own is a filly by Opera King out of a dual winning Splendor mare and is the half sister to 5 winners incl. Hunter's Road, who won 5 races up to a mile, and was Gr3 placed. The 2nd dam was a SW in Zim.

#44 Miss Zumwudd is a filly by King Of Kings. She is out of the Aus-bred Sri Pekan mare Countess Of Orzi, who won four races over 1900/2000m and whose only previous foal is an unraced 2yo.

#45 Road To Royalty is a colt by Albarahin out of a young daughter of Al Mufti, whose only previous foal has been placed in a brief career to date. The dam is a half sister to SW Royal Kashan and a full sister to Stakes placed Royal Splendor.

#46 Approachable is a colt from the first crop of Gr1 Dubai Duty Free winner Flight Approach. This youngster is out of an Arg-bred mare and is the half bro to a pair of 3 times wnrs. This is the family of Arg- champion 3yo Cheyenne.

#47 Queen Charlotte is by King Of Kings out of a French-bred mare by Primo Dominie who has bred five winners from five runners. Second dam Dame Foolish was the second highest rated 2yo filly of her year in England. This is the family of unbeaten SA champion 2yo filly Private Reserve.

#48 Gemstone Creek is a colt by Mogok out of a winning Northern Guest mare and is the half brother

to 1 winner from only 2 runners out of the dam. Second dam Clear Creek won the Listed (now Gr3) Flamboyant Stakes and was beaten a whisker in the Gr1 Cape Paddock S. There's plenty of black type in the pedigree of this youngster, who is in-bred 4x3 to Northern Dancer.

#49 Houghton is a son of King Of Kings out of an unraced Northern Guest mare who has not yet been represented at the races. The dam is a half sister to Gr3 winner Glenforth from the family of champion stayer Speedy Dollar. This colt is in-bred 3x3 to Northern Dancer.

#50 Al Karief is a filly from the first crop of ill-fated flying machine Cataloochee and must be one for any shortlist. She is out of an unraced Dancing Champ mare who has bred 6 winners from 7 runners. The dam is a half sister to Gr3 placed sprmr Bold Bolero.

#51 is an unnamed Silvino filly and is the half brother to 2 times winning sprinter from only two foals to race out of her dam. She's out of a daughter of very useful broodmare sire Flaming Rock who won two races over 1200m. The second dam produced 7 foals, all to race, six of them winners.

#52 Royal Regalia is a colt by King Of Kings and is the half brother to 5 winners from 5 foals to race out of his dam, incl. a 4 times winner. He's out of an Elliodor mare who won 3 races up to 2000m and is in-bred 4x3 to Northern Dancer. This is the family of recent Gr3 winner Bayete.

#53 Joshua's Kidisa colt by very good sire Joshua Dancer. There won't be too many opportunities to invest in yearlings by this sire, whose fertility problems are no secret. The yearling is out of the 3 times winning National Emblem mare Emblem Kid, whose only previous foal is an unraced 2yo. This is the immediate family of this season's Listed winning Cape 2yo filly Squashy Joy. The 2nd dam produced 8 winners.

#54 Humble King is a son of King Of Kings out of a Lustramare and is in-bred 4x3 to Northern Dancer. He's the half brother to a 2 times winner out of a half sister to multiple Gr3 winning stayer Yankee Blue Dill.

#55 Police The Poppy is a colt by Albarahin. He is the first foal of Fard mare Feast Of Flowers, who won 3 races over 1000m. The mare's a half sister to the dam of this season's Gauteng Gr3 winner Prestic, from the family of Gr1 winning sprinter Tobe Or Nottobe.

#56 Wind Speed's another colt by Joshua Dancer to make particular note of. He's the 1st foal of All Fired Up mare Fire Maker, who won 4 races over 1800/2000m, from the family of dual Aus Gr3 winner Slygo Connection.

#57 Tee Vee is a Second Empire filly and is out of a winning Our Casey's Boy mare who has bred 2 wnrs from 3 mns. Second dam Nandi Flame was a SW and produced 7 wnrs of 19 races.

#58 Smoking Josh is a colt by Joshua Dancer who looks bred to fly. He is out of a Golden Thatch mare who won one race over 1000m and who produced the 3 times winning sprinter Spinifex from only 2 previous foals. The dam's a half sister to 7 wnrs incl. Stakes placed Wild Daisy (dam of SW Running Wild) and Sunny Flame.

#59 Moja is from the 3rd crop of

Danzig horse Bezin, who sired a Gr3 wnr in his 1st crop of juveniles. This yearling is the half sister to 4 wnrs incl. Gr3 wnr and Gr2 runner-up Foxi Flo. The dam, Floating Taxi, is a daughter of Taxiarchos who won 6 up to 2000m incl. 4 Stakes events. The 2nd dam's 4 foals to race all won.

#60 Opt For Opera is a filly by Opera King out of an unraced Kefaah mare whose only previous foal is an unraced 2yo. The dam is a full sister to multiple Stakes placed 6 times wnrr Power Of Protest, from a very good and venerable Birch Bros family.

#61 Chattagoon's a colt by The Sheik. He's out of a winning Mount Hagen mare and is the half brother to 1 wnr. The dam's a half sister to 7 wnrs incl. exported Gr2 wnr Bianconi, SW Tom And Jerry, and Stakes placed Catch Twenty Two and Fandango Flyer. The mare's also a half sister to the dam of multiple Gr2 placed Real Red.

#62 Magnanimous is another son of The Sheik. He's out of a mare by Northern Guest who won 3 races over 1400/1600m and who is not yet represented at the races. Second dam Femme Grise was Gr3 placed in France and bred 6 winners from 7 runners.

#63 Heaven City is a colt by Modus Vivendi. She's the half sister to 2 wnrs, one of them in turn the dam of a 4 times wnr, from the family of Gr1 winner Miss Averof.

#64 Cador's a Mon Sang colt out of a winning Linney Head who has bred one winner from 2 runners. The 2nd dam finished 4th at Gr3 level and produced 3 winners from as many runners.

#65 Hit A High is a filly by Albarahin out of a Kefaah mare who won 1 over 1200m. The dam has not yet been represented at the races. The 2nd dam bred 7 wnrs from 7 mns, incl. a 5 time and a 4 time winner.

#66 Fire Fox is a colt by Mon Sang out of a dual winning speed mare by Tilden and is the half brother to this season's winning 2yo Red October. The 2nd dam has produced 6 wnrs from 6 mns incl. Gr3 runner-up Sea Chest (in Zim). This is a very solid Zim female line.

#67 You're My Sister is a filly from the 3rd crop of Sarge, who has sired wnrs from limited chances to date. She's out of the winning Sportswood mare Mabaleng, whose 2 wnrs to date incl. this season's successful 2yo Seven Network. The 2nd dam Siver Divine bred 10 wnrs from 12 foals incl. SW Ndizani, a full sister to the dam of this yearling.

#68 Mr Mellochee's a colt from the first crop of dual Gr1 winning sprinter Cataloochee out of a winning mare by Model Man. The 2nd dam Melly Maloy won 6 incl. the Listed (now Gr3) Flamboyant S and bred 5 wnrs incl. 3 times Listed winner Molly Mandy.

#69 La Lampara's a colt by successful young sire Mogok and is worth the wait for the last lot in the catalogue. He's out of the 3 times winning Foveros mare Midlands Meander and is the half brother to 2 winners incl. 5 times winner Jet Man. The mare's a full sister to the dam of Gr2 runner-up Sahara, who herself is by Mogok, making the yearling a full brother in blood to that very good performer.
