CURRENCY CONQUERS

The power of the foreign buying bench has always been a strategic balancing factor in the thoroughbred sales scheme of things. And the awesome impact was underlined in dramatic style on the opening day of our National Yearling Sale yesterday.

The previous record for any horse sold in a South African sales arena was smashed when Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid al Maktoum paid R9 million for what most observers thought was an absolutely perfect Silvano colt called Masaki from the world-class Mauritzfontein Stud.

Mike de Kock and the Hong Kong Jockey Club's Mark Richards were amongst the sparring bidders as the electronic scoreboard climbed to new highs in front of an awestruck audience. Like many battles, there is a conqueror and the final shot was fired with the pendulum swinging in favour of South African horseracing's greatest ambassador of all time.

De Kock planted his flag and soberly pointed out that they have spent more elsewhere, while conceding that the price tag was also not insignificant in international terms.

At current rates of exchange the purchase price equates to something in the region of US\$ 620 000, A\$ 840 000 and £ 480 000.

While comparisons can be tailored to suit arguments and probably serve no real purpose, it's worth noting that In February this year, a Brazen Beau colt, knocked down for A\$ 550 000, became the highest-priced yearling ever sold in the 50 years of an Inglis Classic Sale. The previous high was A\$ 480 000 set in 2018.

In 2018 the Goffs UK Premier Sale hosted a new record price of £380 000 for a smashing Gleneagles colt.

When interviewed by Michelle Wing who put it to the straightshooting veteran that it was a 'tremendous moment', De Kock quipped:

"It's a tremendous moment yes. And it will be a tremendous moment too when he wins. He's a November foal so I will throw him out. He won't be an early horse," said the man who trains our current boom 3yo Hawwaam – also a son of Silvano- who races in the same internationally renowned blue and white finery.

Masaki was the penultimate lot on a day that actually started quite nervously- four of the first six lots offered failed to make their reserves.

If nothing absolutely sensational happens over the next two days – and he was touted by De Kock as the horse of the sale - Masaki will be the fourth straight top-seller at South Africa's most important sale to be acquired by international interests – that after Sugar Girl got the ball rolling back in 2016, followed by Ghaalla and Track Attack in 2017 and 2018, respectively. Bloodstock SA's Gary Grant acknowledged the importance of international interest in the South Africa racing industry.

"It is important to acknowledge the role that the Maktoum family have played in allowing the South African thoroughbred industry to showcase their product on the international stage. The tremendous support by the Eastern market was also notable and much appreciated at Wednesday's sale."

While the big league players are not overly distracted by rands and 'sense' – who knows which way our currency marches after next month's national elections- the omnipresent dark shadow of our export protocols bogey has not appeared to chase too many away – with overseas buyers actually accounting for more than 30% of the first day turnover of R73 855 000.

That figure showed a decline on last year's R77 420 000. To be fair, 25 horses failed to sell this year, as opposed to 27 in 2018. Both the average and median prices dipped, with the average dropping from R545 211 to R535 181 and the median falling from R325 000 to R250 000.

Dynasty Filly Tops The Charts

Ridgemont Highlands four times Equus Outstanding Stallion Dynasty, whose passing rocked the industry last month, produced the top-selling filly on an historic Day One of the Emperors Palace National Yearling Sale and ended the buoyant first stretch as the second leading sire on aggregate.

The Drakenstein Stud-bred Kim Soo (#98), one of only five Dynasty daughters to sell on the day, is out of Gr1 winner Happy Archer (Dubawi). She was purchased by Form Bloodstock for R4,3-million. <u>Read more here</u>

Winter's Upon Us

Gr3 Winter Guineas Kenilworth Saturday

Vaughan Marshall's star Captain Al colt One World – beaten only once in seven starts – and then by subsequent Gr1 Horse Chestnut Stakes winner Soqrat in the Cape Guineas – steps out for his first run since his big win in the richly endowed CTS 1600 on Sun Met day.



Saturday's mile contest is the first leg of the R1 million Cape Winter Series and with Vaughan Marshall not travelling to KZN for the big season, the high-class Concorde Cup winner One World adds some genuine sparkle to the ever bleaker Cape winter months. Anton Marcus takes the ride again on the smart colt who swept all before him, before being halted in his tracks

by Soqrat in the Cape Guineas. Given Soqrat's smart performances in the Queen's Plate and the Horse Chestnut Stakes, it was no mean feat to play second fiddle to the Aussie galloper and only the progressive Vardy looks capable of stopping him.

A winner of 3 of his 5 starts, Vardy was well and truly slammed 3,75 lengths by One World on Met day – but superior fitness may balance the tables. He won his return start on 3 April and has the edge on race exercise.

Majestic Mozart was beaten just under 2 lengths by Vardy last time and now takes the Marcus galloper on at 4kgs worse terms. He looks likely to be more competitive in the second and third legs.

Clouded Hill gets the blinkers removed and looks a rare -Snaith-Fourie runner likely to start at double figure odds. The son of Horse Chestnut comes off a thirteen week break and appears to have lost form noticeably at his three starts.

Herodotus has not run for thirteen weeks since a commendable third placed finish in the Cape Derby. The son of Trippi was not disgraced through the Cape Summer Season, but realistically would prefer further and looks well held over the mile by One World.

Russet Air looks well held by Vardy on their last meeting when, in

Who Will Be Next?

The Highlands bred Dynasty gelding African Night Sky became only the second horse in history, after Pocket Power in 2006, to win the R1-million Cape Winter Series for 3-year-olds.

The Justin Snaith trained galloper lifted the Winter 'Triple Crown' honours in 2017.

Bernard Fayd'herbe, who takes the ride on Majestic Mozart on Saturday for Candice Bass-Robinson, was the winning pilot on both historic occasions.

The series, often run on testing typically Cape winter ground, also comprises the R250 000 Gr3 Winter Classic run over the Kenilworth winter course 1800m on Saturday 25 May, reaching a climax on 29 June with the running of the R250 000 Gr3 Winter Derby over the stamina sapping 2400m.

A bonus of R250 000 will be paid to the owner/s of the horse that wins all three legs of the Winter Series.

Helen Could Be Ready

Sweert Chestnut Stakes (L) Kenilworth Saturday

The Ideal World filly Helen's Ideal only has to beat her wide draw to go close to lifting the laurels in the R150 000 Listed Sweet Chestnut Stakes at Kenilworth on Saturday.

Birch Boy Bumps The Babes

East Cape Nursery (L) Fairview Friday

The top-class Madame Speaker broke the ice for the fairer sex in last year's East Cape Nursery and the roses could overwhelm the thorns again in the 2019 renewal of the R150 000 listed feature.

The Fillies Nursery top two of Brandina and Captain Anne Bonny dominate the SP ratings for the 1200m contest where the unbeaten Vercingetorix colt Viking Moon looks to make it three on the trot.

Captain Anne Bonny popped up at any price to lower Brandina's colours in the East Cape Fillies Nursery and Tara Laing's home bred galloper looks to repeat the feat.

Brandina had done little wrong with a terrific third placed finish in the Met Day juvenile feature punctuating her two home victories. There should be little between the two again but with Greg Cheyne riding the unbeaten Vercingetorix colt, it looks like we have a major race for the title on our hands.

The two-from-two Viking Moon steps up to the 1200m and bumps the equally promising Hooves Of Troy, who he disposed of by half a length last time.

Foreign Source produced two good seconds at his first two starts before he shed his maiden with some authority by over 5 lengths

Third of the three fillies in the race and one of the Alan Greeff quartet, Pierina ran on well at her second start when beating Speechmaker 3,50 lengths stepping up from the 800m to the 1000m. The daughter of Soft Falling Rain has done little wrong in her two starts and could surprise for place money.

Linden Rock is the first of two maidens in the nine horse field. The Seventh Rock colt has his sixth start and looks held by Gold Dragon when finishing 8 lengths behind.

The second of the Gavin Smith duo, course and distance debut winner Gold Dragon won unfancied and now steps into the higher league. The son of Oratorio looks to have plenty of scope for improvement.

Amber Tree looks well held by Foreign Source when beaten



just under 7 lengths on debut. It looks like a terrific three

New Venue - Trying Again

East Cape Nursery (L) Greyville Sunday

Delayed from last Sunday where the persistent rains cut up the track, the R150 000 Listed The Sledgehammer is now run on the Greyville 1800m this Sunday. It is a traditional low-key season opener for some of the big guns looking to stretch their legs.

The race is weighted on merit rating bands and has attracted a quality field.

Mike and Adam Azzie have been in a rich vein of form in Gauteng and they saddle the SP top-rated smart Western Winter 4yo Orpheus who comes in here on a hat-trick after two smart wins . He has shown ability up to 2400m and seldom runs a bad race. With jockey Marco van Rensburg riding the crest of a wave, he could be tough to peg back.

Snaith's Platinum Prince ran a decent fourth on his SA Champions Season debut in the Kings Cup and will be much fitter and readier for this race. On his best form of last season he must be classed as a major runner – although the jockey engagement of Richard Fourie on the stablemate would suggest that one is preferred.

Paul Lafferty's Our Coys hasn't won a race in close on 15 months and comes in under sufferance. The son of Uncle Mo will have fitness on his side and has run close up recently against weaker.

The enigmatic Eyes Wide Open carries topweight of 61,5kgs and has his first run back since running just over five lengths back in the Sun Met. The son of Dynasty has failed to deliver on a few occasions but is clearly the class act in the race.

Made To Conquer has his first run in 13 weeks since an unplaced effort in the Sun Met when just under 9 lengths behind Rainbow Bridge. The July has already been earmarked as a target for the consistent son of Dynasty who was runner-up behind stablemate Do It Again in the big one last year. Dean Kannemeyer's highly regarded Silva's Bullet is yet to finish out of the money in seven starts and ran a fair third in the Jet Master Stakes at Kenilworth at his last start. The 4yo could up his game to challenge again and should not be disregarded as the yard has turned the corner recently and are in good form.

Gauteng raider Doosra has been well beaten at his last two starts but drops down in class and could revive his fortunes again.

Sean Tarry's lightly raced Dynasty entire Shenanigans caught he eye last time when only caught late by the low-flying Pietro Mascagni.

It looks on the short side for the solid Gimmethegreenlight stayer Gimme

Draw Knocks Aussie Hopes

Santa Ana Lane will have to overcome a wide berth if he is to win the Gr1 Chairman's Sprint Prize at Sha Tin on Sunday.

The Freedman camp is not fazed though: "Better 10 than one," Sam Freedman, trainer Anthony Freedman's son, said after the world's top-rated sprinter drew 10 of 10 in the HK\$16 million contest.

"It'll let him get into a nice rhythm and space to breathe. The draw doesn't really matter given his racing style and the relatively small field," he said of the Australian raider, who will aim emulate compatriot and fellow ate closer Chautauqua, successful in 2016.

Connections of Hong Kong's "Big Two" were happy enough. Beat The Clock will break from gate six and his old rival Mr Stunning from gate three.

"I think the draw in six is ok," Beat The Clock's trainer John Size said. "He will probably have to go forward a little bit because there's not much speed in the race. I don't think it's any disaster, it'll be alright."

The Frankie Lor-trained Mr Stunning had the upper hand against his foe in December's G1 Hong Kong Sprint but has been behind Beat The Clock since in the G1 Centenary Sprint Prize and G2 Sprint Cup when Rattan swept by both to cause an upset.

Lor said: "I'm happy, of course; it will be interesting to see if anyone leads. We'll sit behind maybe Little Giant if he decides to go on."

Rattan will most certainly be finishing off late and drew nine, outside of the mares Viddora (7) and Nac Venus (8).

The draw for the FWD Champions Mile saw the world's co-top rated horse Beauty Generation draw gate two of seven. The Size-trained Conte is rated the best of the rest and drew gate seven.

"He's got to be a chance of getting some prize money and if we get some of it we'll be happy. There doesn't seem to be too much speed there so he's got to get over and get closer to the inside," Size said.

The first day of the 2019 Emperors Palace National Yearling Sale yesterday ended with a memorable record moment when the second last lot, a Wilgerbosdrift bred son of Silvano, was purchased by Shadwell SA for R9 million.

The new benchmark, set by the handsome Masaki, outstrips last year's record of R5,2 million paid for the Varsfontein Stud-bred Dynasty colt Track Attack.

Mike de Kock will train lot 184, a full brother to Gr1 winner Nightingale, whose Fort Wood

dam is a Gr3 winning sister to SA Guineas winner Heir Apparent.

The Hong Kong Jockey Club's Mark Richards was the underbidder in the battle for supremacy which ended with the hammer falling at R9 million in favour of Shadwell SA.

His Highness Sheikh Hamdan Bin Rashid Al Maktoum's powerful international racing vehicle also bought the second highest priced lot on the day in the shape of the Varsfontein bred Vasco Da Gama (#115), which sold for 4,4 million.

Dynasty produced the top filly of the day when Drakenstein Stud bred Kim Soo (#98) sold for R4, 3 million (the third highest lot) to Form Bloodstock.

The Hong Kong Jockey Club climbed in early when setting the pace with Mauritzfontein's well-related Querari colt, Ficksburg (#55), who was bought for R4,2 million.

The leading sires were in demand with Silvano's 17 offspring achieving an aggregate of R16 million at an average of R941 176.

The recently deceased champion Dynasty sold 16 for an aggregate of R13 075 000 at an average of R817 188.

Watch history being made

The star Captain Al, whose last showing this was at Nationals, had his 12 sell for R11 575 000 at an average of R964 583.

Day 2 commenced at 11h30 this morning, with Lots 186 - 400 (Session 1 concludes at Lot 240) going under the hammer.

Handicapping Guidelines - NHA Explains **Regulator on their philosophy**

The rationale behind the Handicapping Guidelines as last amended in April 2016 followed from numerous meetings with all stakeholders at which it was unanimously agreed that horses should be protected from over aggressive adjustments and so ensure that they could achieve their fair share of wins.

The National Horseracing Authority advises in a press release published on 24 April 2019, that maximum caps were imposed on all maiden winners, and maiden winners older than three years were capped in such a way as to ensure that, generally speaking, a horse which struggled for some time to win a race would not be forced to compete in a handicap substantially above its capabilities.

In essence, this allows maiden winners to start at the bottom of the ratings pyramid.

It has been a long established practice that winners of ordinary handicaps could not be raised more than eight MR points, excluding any sufferance and/or overweight. This especially protects horses whose winning performance by a wide margin could be flattering or 'once off'.

All winners of Plated, Conditions and Assessment races – except in the case of compulsory runners in terms of the Assessment Plate rules now in force on the Highveld – cannot be raised more than six MR points where applicable, while placed horses cannot be raised at all, except at the request of the connections.

The specific conditions of certain individual races do impose further limitations on the Handicappers' ability to adjust ratings freely.

Thus there are many opportunities for connections to expose to the Handicappers the true ability of their horses, by placing them correctly, without any risk of the horses' ratings being adjusted to those achieved levels. This is not an ideal situation and can amount to "beating the system", but the rationale behind it is understood and applied by the Handicappers.

Charity Turf Challenge 2019 Ready To Play & Win?

This year's Charity Turf Challenge sponsored by Track & Ball Gaming kicks off on "The Independent On Saturday" Drill Hall Stakes Day, Friday 3 May, and finishes on Saturday 27 July headlined by the Gr3 eLan Gold Cup with a supporting cast of top races featuring four Gr1 events.

For those who are trying the competition for the first time, the aim of the Charity Turf Challenge is to select a team of 12 horses (only the top ten point scorers count) you feel are most likely to score points during the official period of the Champions Season. Whilst the emphasis remains on the feature races run in KZN, ALL winners throughout the country will be eligible to earn points.

This is of particular importance as Turffontein's big day on 4 May is obviously included in the competition, so make sure you pay attention to the big guns, especially those that are likely to feature in the KZN Champions Season as well. Historically, the Winter Series in Cape Town has also proven fruitful for those who found emerging stars like Marinaresco, African Night Sky and last year's Winter Classic winner, Rainbow Bridge. SA Title Chase – Lerena Will Make A Call

Gavin Lerena's retainer by Mauritzfontein and Wilgerbosdrift Studs means the ride on Hawwaam will likely be available to another lucky jockey in the Gr1 Premier's Champions Challenge on May 4 at Turffontein as he is probably going to have to ride Cascapedia.

Lerena has just come off a seven day suspension last week and faces two more suspensions, but depending on how his appeals go and his success rate over the next few weeks, he might still chase the National Jockey Championship title.

He said, "I have a lot of ground to make up but if I am in contention I will definitely go for it."

He has ridden 126 winners to date at a strike rate of 26,20% and is 27 winners behind leader Muzi Yeni.

Lerena felt the interference caused by Hawwaam to Approach Control at the 200m mark in the Gr1 SA Classic was "nothing serious", so did not feel it necessary to attend the enquiry. Therefore, he was surprised to receive a seven day suspension. Hawwaam shifted in slightly when powering past Approach Control and jockey Craig Zackey appeared to stop riding for a stride. However, Lerena is hoping the enquiry is re-opened so he can state his case.

Lerena will be appealing against a ten day suspension he received for his ride on Cascapedia in the Grade 2 Hawaii Stakes over 1400m at Turffontein on March 2. The big mare finished a narrow second, but Lerena was charged with failing "to ensure that she did not cause interference to other runners shortly before the finish line." <u>Read more</u>

An Astute Owner Freeman's Notebook

John Newsome passed away on 9 April 2008. In just nine racing seasons and buying only 3 yearlings per year his Fieldspring Racing achieved a formidable stakes winning strike rate that included two Horses Of The Year and three other champions who amassed 21 Gr1 wins between them.

They included:

- Dynasty (Horse of the Year and Equus Champion three-year-old; 4 Gr1 wins) bought by JF
- Free My Heart (Horse of the Year and dual Equus Award winner; seven Gr1 wins) bought by JF
- Rabiya (the only horse bred in John's own name in SA (Equus Champion three-year-old with 3 Gr1 wins)- a mating that JF planned for him
- Eyeofthetiger (Equus Champion three-year-old, a record-breaking Gr1 Durban July) JF had nothing to do with the purchase
- Russian Sage (dual Gr1 winner) JF bought for Snaith to train
- Roman Charger (Cape Champion two-year-old) JF bought for Jack Mitchell and John
- Honour the Guest (two Gr1 wins) JF bought for John
- and many other stakes-winning horses including Wonderlawn (record priced yearling ever sold -R3.3m - he won a few races and an offer of R3.75m was made from Dubai- but Fieldspring wouldn't sell), Royal Opinion, West Coast Gold, National Title, Ivy Green and Spring Lilac (dam of Snow Dance).

Dynasty was best of all. His racing achievements, often debated as being the best of all time- at least the Kannemeyer's and JF thought so- even after Horse Chestnut won the Met; because Dynasty won the July even more impressively.

At stud he was an undisputed star, a complete all-rounder. The youngest of the 'old-guard' to have serial Gr1 winners and multiple champions despite always having fewer runners than the sires ahead of him by stakes. Quadruple Equus Outstanding Sire and with his sire Fort Wood, one of only three sires ever to sire 3 horses of the Year.

He finished the 2017/18 season once again as leading sire on the general log by the qualitative number of stakes winners and by number of stakes races won. He also headed the same general log by AEPR and his 49.3% winners keep him once again in hot contention.

Dynasty: Bought For R475 000

When John Freeman and the late Peter Kannemeyer selected the future superstar Dynasty, who sold as the second highest priced lot at the 2001 National Yearling Sale, the echo of the fall of the auctioneer's hammer signalled the emergence of a 21st century equine legend - and the introduction to South Africa of Fieldspring Racing.

John Freeman recalls that the R475 000 paid late in the sale on the Monday for Wilgerbosdrift's lot 450 – named Dynasty- defied the sometimes unwritten law that high priced horses don't go on to honour their investment.

"I turned to Jack Mitchell – a man with a good eye- and asked him if he'd like to take a half share. He said, 'no thanks'."

He recalled how the late John New-

some, a man who was fairly 'anti-establishment', placed great importance on professional opinion.

"We had to score the yearling – on conformation and then also on pedigree. John Newsome was an astute businessman who expected us to deliver a plan. He wanted three horses. We had to shortlist five. We had meetings and we would discuss it at length with him."

It's quirky how fate sometimes plays a hand in life. A meeting with the legendary Michael Stoute, who trained Commodore Blake – Dynasty's dam sire - formed part of John Freeman's assessment of the good looking youngster. He knew Dynasty's one-time winning dam Blakes Affair was a 'midget'.

"Michael confirmed Commodore Blake as a heck of a racehorse. His own sire was a Derby winner. That stayed with me. And I knew that he stood in the Free State and didn't get too many chances. So when it came to the damline possibly being a bit iffy, I was not too concerned. It is in any event often a negotiable consideration in the overall assessment. Two of our three vets were a bit sceptical too."

John Freeman says that Dynasty's was an 'interesting pedigree' with a predominance of Hyperion.

"Joy Petite was Dynasty's granddam. She was inbred to Lavendula 11. Whose sire Perfume 11 was the dam of Joy 11. I won't go into all the ins and outs of it, but Fort Wood had a propensity to Hyperion line mares."

At the sale, Fort Wood's 14 yearlings sold for R4,5 million and averaged R318 929.

John recalls that he spent over R1 million during that Monday final session for three Fort Wood yearlings – all destined for Dean Kannemeyer's yard.

"I loved Fort Wood – I thought he was the greatest sire in the country. And after the insane prices of the Saturday evening, I was thrilled with my trio."

Dynasty was amongst the first crop of foals born on Mary Slack's new farm below the Piketberg.

"A superb achievement for a brand new farm. We loved him as a specimen – despite the 'negatives'!" Read more here

Domeyer arrives from South Africa with a big reputation, having secured the his first Cape Champion Jockey title last year, earning him a spot in Singapore's International Jockeys' Challenge. He will begin his contract at Happy Valley on May 1. His current strike rate in South Africa sits around 20 per cent, placing him among the best in the world with 980 winners to his name along with three Group One wins.

Hong Kong-based South African trainer Tony Millard had earlier this month publicly called on the Jockey Club to bolster the jockeys' ranks because a lack of depth in top-line riders.

Island Strike!

Multiple SA Champion jockey Piere Strydom has been given the green light by the Mauritius Turf Club to take up a three month contract on the island.

On the recommendation of the Licensing Committee, the Board of Directors of MTC approved the applications of trainers Rameshwar Gujadhur and Amar Sewdyal on 18 April to engage jockeys Piere Strydom and Carlos Herrera Gomez, respectively.

Strydom has been offered a three-month contract to ride for the Rameshwar Gujadhur.

"One of the horses he trains is White River, who was placed in the Cape Guineas when

trained here by Brett Crawford. He's had one run in Mauritius and it won very easily," Strydom was quoted as saying this week as he confirmed that he was awaiting the go ahead.

A nephew of top rider Guillermo Figueroa, the Peruvian Herrera Gomez arrived in South Africa in October last year and rode winners for the Paul Peter yard. He has ridden 9 winners here this season.

The Mauritius Turf Club website has spelt his name differently to our official stats. He rode under the name Carlos Javier Herrera in his homeland.

All that's now awaited is a work permit from the Mauritius government.

Bad Manners – Not In Mauritius!

The Mauritius Turf Club Stewards have reported that they recently inquired into a report from jockey Cedric Ségeon that, following the third race at the race meeting of 7 April 2019, when on his way back to the paddock, he was approached by one of the part owners of the horse Trojan Quest, Mr. Jean Luc Fayolle, who complained about his ride.

Jockey Segeon stated that Mr Fayolle raised his voice at him and addressed him in a rude manner regarding his ride at the start of the race and in the final straight. Both agreed that there were no swear words used during the incident. Jockey Ségeon explained that realising that Mr Fayolle was in a bad mood, he decided not to engage him. Mr. Fayolle explained that the incident did not last very long- he just asked Ségeon what happened at the start and why didn't he take the inside run in the home straight and left the paddock straight after.

Mr Fayolle then stated that he had sent a mail to Mr Ségeon apologising for his behaviour and showed remorse towards the jockey, his trainer Mr Henry and more importantly the MTC. He added that he was aware that this type of behaviour was not appropriate in the middle of the paddock and tendered his apologies to the Stewards.

No action was taken.

Ivan van Wyk

A Tellytrack presenter's recent question in a post-race winner's interview to trainer Ivan van Wyk regarding his training from Yellow Star Stud in Mooi River was met with a polite response that the quietly spoken horseman was now based at Summerveld.

When pursued for more detail, and to how long he'd been at the leading KZN training centre, Ivan replied softly. "Oh, just over a year now."

It happens. Some people just have a knack of selling themselves and grabbing the limelight. Others just carry on – for a year and more below the radar, sometimes!

The 52 year old Colesberg born Niklaas 'Ivan' van Wyk is one of those.

"Maybe I need to promote my business a bit more. But websites, PR and social media are not really my speciality. My horses are my life and they keep me busy," says Ivan, who lives on his business premises and thus technically never leaves his office.

He currently has a string of 35 horses, which includes some exciting 2yo's.

Ivan is best known as the Yellow Star 'sheriff' through his lengthy association with the De Klerk family and the Mooi River breeding establishment.

Formerly owned by KZN breeding legend Craig Ramsay. Yellow Star Stud is situated approximately 12 km outside the village of Mooi River, the hub of thoroughbred breeding in Kwa-Zulu Natal.

The farm is 320 hectares in extent and produces hay for both bedding and horse feed and wholesale and retail. They boast large 'veld' camps of natural grass and many kikuyu paddocks. Green winter feed is planted annually- being either oats or rye grass. The farm boasts 100 stables including a foaling barn of 12 stables and formerly a racing yard of 24 boxes.

It was on the Yellow Star training tracks, grass and sand, where Ivan van Wyk first ran a successful training yard after six years under the tutelage of his mentor, Chris Erasmus . Ivan took out his Trainer's Licence in May 2017 but found the burden of the travelling to races and the maintenance of the tracks was taking time away from his focus on the horses.

"We did remarkably well considering we were travelling over four hours return to Greyville. But the logistics were not ideal. Think about night meetings where the last race could be just

before 22h00. That would mean late nights and early mornings for staff who already work hard. I was also responsible for helping to maintain our excellent training tracks at Yellow Star. And believe me track maintenance is a specialised time consuming process. It takes great effort to keep them in pristine condition."

> Ivan says that every day that he looks at the beautiful facilities available to him and his colleagues at Summerveld, he appreciates the money, effort and expertise that goes into maintaining them.

"I am really pleased with the bold move to Summerveld. I have an open licence and receive great support from the De Klerk family, Ted Hughes, Dr Williams and others who have entrusted me with their horses."

the foundation required to be a top-class horseman.

"His parents worked for the Southeys at Southford Stud. Ivan has the Colesberg blood flowing through his veins and he is one of the most dependable men I know. He doesn't work for us. He runs his business independently. We are jus his main supporters," said the former KZN Breeders Club Chairman.

After leaving Colesberg for the bright city lights of Cape Town, Ivan worked on chicken farms in the Paarl area as a maintenance man. He never married but has a son and daughter who still live in Paarl. He gets to see them a few times a year – but 'not often enough'.

After he spent his early working life amongst chickens and spanners, Ivan always had a yearning to get back amongst horses and it was seventeen years ago

that he landed himself a job as a groom with veteran trainer Chris Erasmus at Turrffontein. It was to be a turning point for the son of Colesberg, who always had stars in his eyes when it came to fast horses.

"I learnt most of what I know from Mr Erasmus, who still advises me today and is only a phone call away."

Ivan, who earned the rank of Assistant Trainer, moved from Johannesburg to Durban in 2011 when Chris Erasmus was put in charge of a string owned by Koos and Lorraine de Klerk at Yellow Star Stud. With a further six years under his belt, Van Wyk was ready to take over when Erasmus departed.

He saddled his first winner at Scottsville in September 2017 when the old warhorse Putchini bounded home at 12-1 under Billy Jacobson.

"I thought I would spend my life in the second or third box and then Putchini delivered the goods. It boosted my confidence tremendously and I'm proud to say he is still the king of the ring here!" laughed Ivan.

He says he has no issues with any of his fellow trainers at Summerveld and is blessed with a loyal staff.

"I'm one of them. I did my time as a Groom and I still get my hands dirty. I know what they are experiencing. It's easier when one relates to those around you,"he adds.

Two At Nationals

Koos and Lorraine De Klerk's Yellow Star Stud will be represented by two lots at the Emperors Palace National Yearling Sale this week.

The Mooi River based farm will be offering two high quality colts by triple Equus Champion and rising star sire What A Winter. A four time Gr1 winning son of triple champion sire Western Winter, and from the same female line as Hyperion and Sir Tristram, What A Winter made an instant impression at stud, and was South Africa's Champion First Crop Sire in 2016-2017.

The champion's first crop was headed by the graded stakes winners Dutch Philip and Magical Wonderland, while What A Winter's second crop includes Gr1 Bidvest Majorca Stakes winner Clouds Unfold and Ibhyai Stakes hero Fabian.

High class racemare Maggie Kay, whose five wins included the Gr3 Magnolia Handicap, has already made her mark at stud as the dam of speedy Gardenia Stakes winner Queen Laurie and Yellow Star Stud will be offering a What A Winter half-brother (Lot 439) to Queen Laurie at the National Sale.

This colt's second dam is a National Assembly half-sister to multiple Gr1 winner Ingleside and this is family of champions Dancing Danzig and Evening Mist.

What A Winter is also represented in this draft by a colt (Lot 465) out of a winning half-sister to millionaire and multiple graded stakes winner Kangaroo Jack, with this colt's second dam being none other than Gr1 Garden Province Stakes runner up Rainbow Flag. Further back, this is the family of the July placed champion Dollar Fortune and Golden Slipper queen Gilded Minaret.

Anton Marcus takes the reins on the Eric Sands trained Rainbow Bridge as the son of Ideal World commences his bid for Vodacom Durban July glory in the R500 000 Gr2 Independent On Saturday Drill Hall Stakes which, together with the R600 000, Gr2 KRA Guineas and the R500 000 Gr2 KRA Fillies Guineas, raise the curtain on the three-month festival of racing.

Ten horses will line up in the Drill Hall Stakes with Dennis Drier's Dynasty filly Lady In Black an interesting inclusion.

Port Elizabeth giantkiller National Park takes on the mighty Soqrat in the KRA Guineas where Joey Ramsden's trophy hungry Twist Of Fate has pulled a key pole position draw. The surprise SA Derby winner Samurai Warrior roudns off a nationally representative bunch of 3yo males.

The Greyville draw gods were not as kind to Ramsden's Cape colleague Brett Crawford who sees his two KRA Fillies Guineas runners Front And Centre and Princess Irene drawing 15 and 14 in the fifteen strong fairer sex classic field.

Cape Fillies Guineas winner Front And Centre looks a real powerhouse and the tactical battle at a strange venue under the lights for the first time against a host of top gallopers.

Why Don't We Race Them?

In an era of flagging industry fortunes, field sizes have become a hot topic in South Africa- with answers not readily available.

Should we be racing with barrier draws after acceptance and are trainers being consulted about programming? And what of the other multitude of reasons?

In this Letter From America – EBN 20 April – entitled 'No Looking Back', it is suggested that the American and European racing and training systems have always been vastly different, and, historically, American racehorses raced more frequently than European horses.

For more than 100 years after American racing finally transitioned from 4m heat racing to "dash" racing after the Civil War, American trainers habitually raced their charges every couple of weeks, building up records like the great 1950s Champion Round Table's 43 wins in 66 lifetime starts that are now viewed as impossible for modern American champions. But is it?

Despite ample and incontrovertible evidence that the average number of lifetime starts for American Thoroughbreds has declined from more than 30 in the 1950s to less than half that number in the 2000s, geneticists tell us that genetic change simply cannot happen that fast.

While physical soundness may have declined measurably (if we could figure out how to accurately measure it) over the last 70 years, genetics alone cannot possibly account for a 50 per cent drop in the most obvious measure of the soundness of the breed.

Blame

Race day medications have taken much of the blame, and it is historically ironic that it is clear that they play a part in reducing the number of starts American horses make since they were initially sold to racing authorities as a way to do just the opposite.

Lasix was supposed to allow more bleeders to race more often, but instead forces trainers to give horses more time between races because it dehydrates and physically debilitates the horse. And non-steroidal anti-inflammatories like Butazolidin mask pain and lead to more breakdowns and therefore fewer starts.

The phenomenal rise in the value of thoroughbreds is also inversely related to the number of starts they are likely to make.

In Round Table's day, the American record price for a thoroughbred yearling was \$87,000 for the Hyperion colt Rise 'N Shine in 1957, and the first \$100,000 yearling did not appear until 1961. Secretariat's record syndication in 1973 opened the floodgates to rising prices and, fittingly, he sired the first seven-figure yearling, the \$1.5m Canadian Bound.

Soon it became more profitable to retire horses to stud than race them. All of those factors have doubtless contributed to the decline in the apparent soundness of the American thoroughbred, but another purely human factor may be just as important.

Hard & Fast

Throughout the 1980s and 90s the dominant American trainer was D Wayne Lukas, who trained his horses fast and hard and ran them often, but toward the end of that period, new owners coming into the sport with an analytical business approach began selecting trainers on the basis of their percentage of winners to runners. <u>Read more here</u>

O'Brien Lines Derby Troops Up

Cape Of Good Hope provided Ireland's 20-time champion Flat trainer Aidan O'Brien with a first success in the £50,000 Listed Investec Blue Riband Trial at Epsom Downs on Wednesday, the opening trial for the £1.5 million Gr1 Investec Derby back at the course on June 1.

Ridden by Ryan Moore, the three-year-old son of Galileo, the 2001 Derby winner, was settled in mid-division in the early stages of the 10-furlong contest as Massam (Mark Johnston/Franny Norton, 25/1) and Sameem (James Tate/Oisin Murphy, 9/1) set a strong pace at the head of affairs.



The front two came back towards the rest of the

seven-runner field approaching Tattenham Corner with 4/1 chance Cape Of Good Hope making eye-catching headway entering the straight.

John Gosden tried to win the race for the fifth year in a row, and seventh time in total, with Turgenev (Frankie Dettori, 11/4) who progressed to take the lead at the two-furlong pole, before O'Brien's charge swept to the front well inside the final furlong.

Cape Of Good Hope had to hold off the late challenge of the Ed Walker-trained Cap Francais (Gerald Mosse, 5/1), who raced keenly, but made good headway from last to finish a half-length behind the winner in second.

Turgenev was a further three-quarters of a length back in third. The well-backed 9/4 favourite Arthur Kitt (Tom Dascombe/Richard Kingscote) stumbled badly leaving the stalls, nearly unseating the jockey and failed to trouble the leaders, finishing fifth. The winning time was 2m 6.28s on ground described as Good, Good to Firm in places.

The winner of the Investec Blue Riband Trial usually gains a wildcard entry into the G1 £1.5 million Investec Derby, but Cape Of Good Hope had already been entered in Britain's premier Classic and richest race.


The colt earned a quote for Investec Derby glory of 25/1 from Unibet, official betting partner of the Investec Derby Festival.

Cape Of Good Hope, owned by a Coolmore partnership, is a full-brother to globetrotting superstar Highland Reel, a seven-time Gr1 winner, who won the 2017 Ge1 Investec Coronation Cup at Epsom Downs on his only outing at the course, and Idaho, who was third in the 2016 G1 Investec Derby behind Harzand.

Magic Mr Mullins!

Trainer Willie Mullins saddled the first three in the BoyleSports Irish Grand National on Saturday as 6-1 favourite Burrows Saint led home his stablemates.

It has been a season to forget for owner Rich Ricci, but he has something to celebrate now as his progressive sixyear-old scored under Ruby Walsh.

in March, before which the record-breaking trainer had won neither race.

Sporting Life reports that the well-backed favourite was given a confident ride by Walsh, who went on three from home and had enough in hand to fend off both his stable companions.

"I don't really want to be taking part anymore, I want to win. That's why I went for the unexposed horse," said Walsh, winning the race for a third time.

"He made one or two novicey mistakes, but he got into a great rhythm when the race slowed down. He got travelling really well in a lovely position beside Danny, and after that he jumped super most of the way."

Mullins was less sure that his long-time stable jockey had made the right choice as his hoodoo in the race was finally ended.

"I was a little surprised Ruby chose him as I thought he might go for something with more experience," said the winning trainer. "Obviously he gave him a great feel the two days he won on him. I think that's his third run in six weeks, so it shows what kind of ability he might have in the future."

He added: "It was a tremendous result. It's just been one of those years where we have done things that we haven't done before.

"It's tremendous for Ruby and tremendous for Rich Ricci. We're delighted to win it for the yard too."

Isleofhopendreams (20-1) was beaten a head in the 2018 renewal and again had to settle for second, with Acapella Borgeois (18-1) third.

"I thought for a couple of seconds that Danny (Mullins) might win it jumping the last, as he was coming with a wet sail," said Mullins.

"It was another good run from him as he was second last year."

A New Threat Emerges

The British Horseracing Authority is pumping £1 million (R18.3 million) into pioneering research into gene doping after experts warned it could present the "dawn of a new era".

Gene manipulation methods for performance enhancement in racehorses could range from cloning to the delivery of an EPO hormone gene, raising serious integrity and welfare concerns.

A leading scientist said gene doping had been discussed in the racing industry and was at the stage where "if people wanted to use it and had enough money they could definitely do it".

The BHA's pledge to fund the research, which will take place at scientific advisory group LGC's laboratory in Newmarket, was made in recent months but the study's scope has not been finalised. It is hoped the £1 million, which covers a five-year programme, will help to improve detection of gene doping.

Testing on "study horses" is expected to be part of the research and is due to begin later this year.

Dr James Scarth, LGC's head of animal sports testing, told the Partnership for Clean Competition conference in London: "Something we are just getting into, in the same way as human sports, is gene doping. We've been talking about this for a long time, I know the industry has. But we are now seeing the dawning of a new era."

The BHA decision to fund this research came after racing federations across the world identified gene doping as a future threat and the BHA wants to be ahead of the curve.

David Sykes, the BHA's director of equine health and welfare, already sits on the Gene Doping Control Subcommittee of the International Federation of Horseracing Authorities.

Gene doping, which could make horses faster or stronger, able to train harder or recover quicker from races, is different from gene therapy, where genes are manipulated or inserted to help cure injury or disease.

A recent study in Russia used "direct gene therapy" on two badly injured horses, both of which experienced "complete recovery of functions and full restoration of the severely damaged suspensory ligament and superficial digital flexor tendon".

However, the academics behind that study, published in the Frontiers in Veterinary Science journal, acknowledged that a considerable amount of work, including wider clinical trials, were needed before judgments could be made.

Discussing that research, Scarth said: "There were these animals that had really severe ligament and tendon injuries and were given vascular endothelial growth factor and fibroblast growth factor and they completely healed. We are acutely aware of what impact this could have."

Sources said there are "ethical concerns" in the industry about gene editing and there are worries about its use outside of a laboratory or veterinary setting. It is expected the BHA-funded research will seek to determine appropriate and inappropriate uses of gene manipulation. www.dailymail.co.uk

A Sweet Success Story!

While Ride The Rails is not perhaps a name which immediately springs to mind when asked to consider the sire of an exceptional international racehorse and sire, he certainly fits that bill, with his multiple Gr1 winning son Candy Ride currently one of North America's most successful stallions.

Unbeaten in three outings in Argentina, where he was named Champion Miler after capturing a pair of Gr1 races, Candy Ride was unbeaten in three US outings, with his all-too brief North America campaign ending in a dominant three and a quarter length romp over another subsequent star sire, Medaglia D'Oro, in the 2003 Gr1 Pacific Classic.

Remarkably, as brilliant as he was on the track, Candy Ride has been even more outstanding at stud.

The bay retired to stud in 2005, and has since gone on to sire over 70 black type winners- Candy Ride's current stats have him at siring 6% stakes winners to foals. His progeny include 14 individual Gr1 winners and six champions.

He has produced both Gr1 winning colts and fillies, although no fewer than 11 of Candy Ride's top level winners are male, and his very best runners to date, Gun Runner, Shared Belief and Game Winner were also male.

Candy Ride's progeny have built up a tremendous record in major US races thus far, with notable races won by his runners including such Gr1 contests as the Breeders' Cup Classic, Breeders' Cup Juvenile, Santa Anita Handicap (twice), Pegasus World Cup, Woodward Stakes, Malibu Stakes (twice), and the Clark Handicap. This record could have been even more impressive had his champion son Shared Belief not died after a colic surgery in 2015.

The Lane's End stallion has enjoyed notable success when mated to Storm Cat line mares, with this cross producing at least five Gr1 winners to date, notably Horse Of The Year Gun Runner- whose dam



was sired by Storm Cat's best sire son Giant's Causeway. Four of Candy Ride's most recent black type winners, including Gr2 San Vincente winner Sparky Ville, are out of mares either by Storm Cat or by a son of Storm Cat, while his unbeaten son Mastery's granddam was sired by Storm Cat, and Speightstown- whose dam is by Storm Cat – broodmare sire of Candy Ride's current top class 3yo Vekoma.

Candy Ride also looks well poised to make a major impact on the US Triple Crown races this year, with his 3yos including current leading Kentucky Derby hopes Game Winner and Vekoma. An unbeaten Breeders' Cup Juvenile winning champion at two, Game Winner was second most recently when just run out of it in the G1 Santa Anita Derby. His paternal half-brother Vekoma has won graded stakes at both two and three and recorded a 3.5 length win in the Gr2 Toyota Blue Grass Stakes most recently.

The unbeaten star, whose progeny have already earned in excess of \$93 000 000, is also making an impact as a sire of sires, with Candy Ride's stallion sons currently headed by Twirling Candy.

The latter, a Gr1 Malibu Stakes winner from the same female line as Triple Crown winner Affirmed, is currently the sire of at least 16 black type winners, including recent Gr1 Santa Anita Handicap winner Gift Box and Gr1 Madison Stakes queen Finley'sluckycharm.

With a growing number of sire sons entering stud, such as Gun Runner and the brilliant, unbeaten Mastery, Candy Ride, descended, like Seattle Slew and Mr Prospector, in female line from the mare Stray Shot, looks poised to enjoy further success as a sire of sires.

Candy Ride himself is one of 22 stakes winners sired by now deceased Cryptoclearance horse Ride The Rails –who won four times and was second in the Gr1 Florida Derby. Ride The Rails's second dam, the multiple stakes winner Alanesian, was a very influential producer whose offspring included Seattle Slew's grandsire Boldnesian as well as Gr1 Hollywood Gold Cup winner Princessnesian.

The multiple Gr1 winning Cryptoclearance was a son of influential sire Fappiano, whose numerous high class sire descendants include Unbridled, Unbridled's Song, Empire Maker, and Pioneerof The Nile – whose Triple Crown winning son American Pharoah recently had a first winner from his very first starter.

However, it is also worth noting the impact that Candy Stripes, broodmare sire of Candy Ride, has had in North America. Not only did the Blushing Groom horse sire US Horse Of The Year Invasor and fellow champion Leroidesanimaux but the latter is responsible for 2011 Kentucky Derby winner Animal Kingdom.

Interestingly enough, Candy Ride's half-sister Candy Singer (by Singspiel) has made her mark in South Africa. A five time winner herself, Candy Singer scored her biggest victory when downing G1 SA Classic winner Pierre Jourdan to win the 2011 Gr3 Jubilee Handicap.

Not surprisingly, given her race record and pedigree, Candy Singer was quick off the mark at stud –her 3 runners are headed by Lady's Bracelet winner Merysagos and Gr3 Byerley Turk second Baritone. BREEDING

Drakenstein Stud's five time Gr1 winner and Cartier Champion has been enjoying a great run of success, with his offspring winning all over South Africa in recent times, and the champion son of Danehill enjoyed yet another treble this past Saturday.

Duke Of Marmalade's Saturday treble was highlighted by two eye catching juvenile winners, with Hertog and Sanskrift both winning their respective races.

Trained by Paul Matchett, the Ndoro Stud bred Hertog got off the mark at just the second time of asking when he saluted by three-parts of a length, over 1000m at Turffontein on Saturday.Just a few minutes later, Hertog's paternal half-sister Sanskrift gave Duke Of Marmalade a two-year-old double for the day when she romped to get off the mark at the second time out when victorious by a length and a quarter over 1250m at Durbanville.

The beautifully bred Sanskrift, whose classy full-sister Santa Clara holds an entry in the upcoming G2 K R A Fillies Guineas, was a close up second on debut and she looks a potential feature race contender in the making!

Duke Of Marmalade, whose son Marauding became his third local winner on Saturday when scoring a facile maiden win at Durbanville, has now been responsible for three two-year-old winners this season, with this tally including the exciting and unbeaten filly True To Life. The latter holds entries in both the upcoming Gr2 SA Nursery and Gr2 SA Fillies Nursery.

At stud he failed to get the support but produced a first winner from less than a handful of mares, when the aptly named Gotcaughtspeeding won on his Fairview all-weather debut on Easter Monday.

Bred by Hemel 'n Aarde, the diminutive winner is out of the one-time winning Casey Tibbs mare, Irish Darling. Relaxed early on, Ryan Munger produced the Yvette Bremner trained chestnut late in the 1100m dash and he ran on powerfully to win going away.

After a racing career that saw him win four times from 1200m to 1400m, with a stakes best third in the Gr3 Merchants, Divine Jet, a son of champion Jet Master and a half-brother to a multiple Gr1 winner, achieved a respectable career high MR of 112 and stood his first season at Hemel 'n Aarde.

He has since moved on to Brad van der Riet in the Eastern Cape. David Hepburn-Brown told the Sporting Post that the support just wasn't there.

The ever optimistic Brad van der Riet of Vanree Stud, who is now based in the Golden Triangle, says he has purchased five mares specifically to be covered by Divine Jet.

"We have to keep trying. Elliodor made it with five mares!" he quipped.

When Divine Jet made his debut early as a 3yo for Dean Kannemeyer in August 2011, he started at odds-on in a field of sixteen at Clairwood. Slow away, he scored a comfortable win. <u>Read more here</u>



Madonna gave me a good feel and I feel she could hold her own against stronger," said Munger, who had earlier ridden a winner for Alan Greeff and a double for Yvette Bremner, to make it four on the day.

Madonna started a 14-10 favourite and was a popular winner. The highly rated local Just Chaos tired late and ran third a further 3,25 lengths back.

A daughter of Dynasty (Fort Wood), the Drakenstein Stud-bred Madonna is out of the Rambo Dancer mare, Prestine Performer – which makes her a half sister to SA Derby winner Seal and Jet Master Stakes winner Fifty Cent.

Bred Abroad

The Dennis Drier-trained Cabo Da Cruz (see previous page) registered his hat-trick at Scottsville on Sunday to make it three wins in seven starts. The Irish-bred 4yo looks to have plenty of ability. A first winner for his dam Pardoven (Clodovil), he was bred by Ringfort Stud. Since being established by Derek and Gay Veitch at the turn of the century, Ringfort Stud in County Offaly has grown to be one of Ireland's premier nurseries and was among the leading vendors at both the Goffs and Tattersalls foal sales last year. Cabo Da Cruz sire Cape Cross died in April 2017 after making a major impact with outstanding performers Golden Horn, Ouija Board and Sea The Stars. The son of Green Desert had been a stalwart of Kildangan Stud, having stood every season at Darley's stallion base in County Kildare in Ireland since his retirement in 2000. He is one of only 17 stallions to have sired more than one Derby winner, and also made his impact on the 2014 Classic as the broodmare sire of Australia. Cape Cross earned his shot as a stallion by winning the Lockinge Stakes, Queen Anne Stakes and Celebration Mile for Godolphin. Introduced to breeders at a fee of just Ir£8,000, he demonstrated he was capable of upgrading his mares by supplying a double-digit tally of first-crop two-year-old winners by Royal Ascot of 2003. By the end of his freshman season he had four stakes winners along with a number of stakes-placed horses – including Ouija Board, who had finished third in the Listed Montrose Stakes.

As Cape Cross entered his sophomore season his fee was doubled to €20,000 from €10,000 and better was to come as Ouija Board established herself as an exceptional talent by winning the Epsom and Curragh Oaks and the Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf. Sea The Stars' exploits no doubt encouraged Anthony Oppenheimer to breed his mare Fleche D'Or to Cape Cross, which created the third pivotal horse in the stallion's career – Golden Horn, who also won the Derby, Eclipse, Irish Champion Stakes and Arc last year. Cape Cross has produced more than 50 Group winners and 52 Listed winners, figures which could still be improved.
